The **restavek school** kitchen has been rebuilt. No longer will the headmaster, Amos, have to

scrounge for expensive wood. With a generous donation of design work from Kuhn-Riddle Architects in Amherst, local workers were able to

build a kitchen that includes work space, storage, and security. A bonus is the kitchen area they built for the handicapped school that



leases the same space. Now the school will have four propane burners that will cook less expensively. Thanks to South Amherst Congregational Church, whose generous gift made the restavek school kitchen possible.

The **Flathead reservation** in Montana - In July, OFC will be helping to prepare the powwow grounds and our volunteers will attend the regional powwow. We are establishing a long-term relationship with this community to develop programs with the two tribes, Salish and Kootenai, who live there.
